Park Lane School Policy

Conjunctivitis

This is an extremely condition affecting the eyes. It is characterised by red, weepy eyes which feel sore and itchy. Your child maybe intolerant to light and a discharge of pus can cause the eyelids to stick together. Your child should not come into School for at least 24 hours after any discharge or inflammation has been apparent. Your Doctor will prescribe drops which generally work very quickly.

NB <u>If antibiotics are prescribed your child should be kept away from</u> <u>School for a minimum period of 48 hours after starting the course.</u>
