The Workspace for Autism programme blends skills development in the form of:

- · Employability training programme CVs, Interview Skills etc
- Careers guidance who is hiring, how transferable skills can be utilised
- · Assisted job search identifying opportunities
- Mentoring and life coach services working towards goals

The programme is aimed at those candidates who require a more personalised service and includes the following elements:

- · Lack of knowledge regarding new/emerging occupations
- Beliefs relating to moving away from benefits and use of in work benefits
- Beliefs relating to employer reactions and value for unemployed people
- Understanding how best to communicate with potential employers
- · Improving opportunities to sustain employment
- · Activities to support independent travel
- Activities to support working with recruitment agencies

In addition to the above sessions will focus on:

- a) Self presentation for Interviews and Job Fairs
- b) Employment Placements and Volunteering
- c) Self Perception and how this relates to confidence and self esteem

- * A NICE compliant Multi -disciplinary assessment including Occupational Therapy & Psychiatry.
- * More than a yes/no assessment report- ie, whatever the opinion, helpful advice on what it means to the person & their supporter's.
- * Clear recommendations on the application of reasonable adjustments, how to maximise the person's strengths, address their needs & support them in achieving their aspirations.
- * Appointments in every CCG locality
- * Centralised information, advice and support to wider CWP services to maximise the engagement of autistic adults and the outcomes of any interventions.

Referrals accepted directly from a GP or any CWP service. Acceptance criteria:

- Adults aged 18+ Wirral and East Cheshire CCGs (16+ for West Cheshire, South Cheshire and Vale Royal CCGs)
- Adults who score 6 or above on an initial self- assessment screening tool (AQ10) and where traits appear to be longstanding


